OBJECTIVE

Twenty year old house kitchen remodel. Client wanted to bring out the charm of living on a lake and create an open concept design.

PROCESS

After client consultation, the design plan was confirmed involving wall removal, relocation of the kitchen with updated cabinets, countertops, lighting and appliances. A contractor was selected for the structural design and construction.

OUTCOME

Open atmosphere, coastal decor and an abundance of outside light with lake views was achieved.





OBJECTIVE

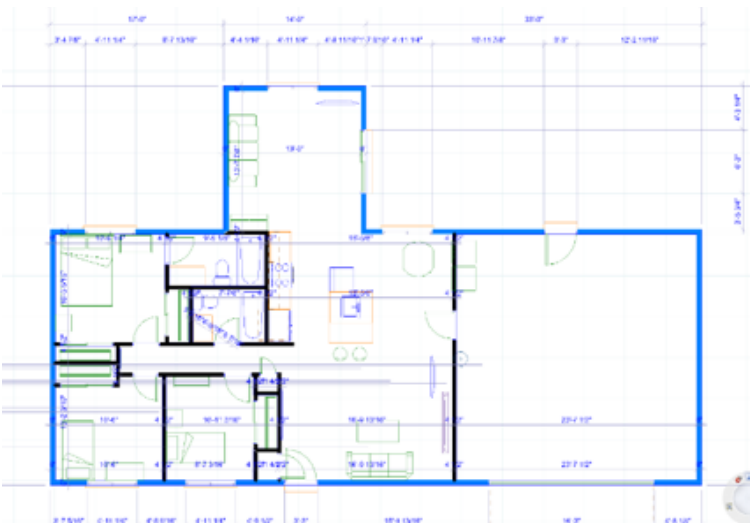
1970's split level home required complete redesign under tight budget and time-frame. Open concept was desired.

PROCESS

Due to center bay window, the kitchen space was maintained with new custom cabinets, quartz countertops, lighting and appliances.

OUTCOME

I designed a U-shaped peninsula kitchen to accommodate an open concept. The specular finish of materials proved to brighten the space. The beautified updated home hit the market and immediately sold.



OBJECTIVE

Complete remodel of 1950's rambler home. The objective was to redefine the movement inside. Remodel kitchen, rooms, garage, and add bathroom, deck, and closet.

PROCESS

Blueprints from the contractor were provided where I took the design process 3D. Using the 3D renderings the client was able to visualize design concepts. I oversaw room-to-room continuity with materials and aesthetic. I oversaw purchasing and delivery coordinating with installation and contractors.

OUTCOME

After I designed the layout and hardware within the house, I also staged the property for sale resulting in a successful renovation. Many buyers appreciated the mid-century vibe resonating from the rambler style and design execution.



OBJECTIVE

Client wanted to create a detached garage with an apartment living space above. High influences of lodge appeal.

PROCESS

I helped to think passed the excavation once the blueprint had been decided. I worked with the owners on tile, slate, and paint selections, all aimed at meeting their love for natural earth tones. Once inside the space, the owners decided to change the bar area into a full functioning kitchen. I accommodated their wishes and on the spot designed a functional space.

OUTCOME

The income producing rental above the garage is in full use. The lodge design is sturdy and will hold up to heavy ware. This design is tailored to the active lifestyle with multiple lofts and closet spaces.
